

What is a Regional Representative?

LFMA members select 8 Regional Representatives to serve on the Board of Directors. The Representative assists in providing information and acts as a contact to the people in their area, submit concerns/issues to the LFMA, and possibly assists in hosting a LFMA workshop in their community. Each Representative shall represent the membership in a geographic region defined as follows:

- Region 1: Jefferson, Orleans, Plaquemines, St Bernard, and St. Tammany Parishes
- Region 2: Ascension, E. Baton Rouge, E. Feliciana, Iberville, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, St. Helena, Tangipahoa, Washington, W. Baton Rouge, and W. Feliciana Parishes
- Region 3: Assumption, Lafourche, St. Charles, St. James, St. John the Baptist, and Terrebonne Parishes
- Region 4: Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, and Vermillion Parishes
- Region 5: Allen, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, and Jefferson Davis Parishes
- Region 6: Avoyelles, Catahoula, Concordia, Grant, LaSalle, Rapides, Vernon, and Winn Parishes
- Region 7: Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Claiborne, DeSoto, Lincoln, Natchitoches, Red River, Sabine, and Webster Parishes
- Region 8: Caldwell, E. Carroll, Franklin, Jackson, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union and W. Carroll Parishes

Requirements:

- Be a member of LFMA
- Attend half-day Board meetings held once a quarter throughout the State
- One year term (unlimited)
